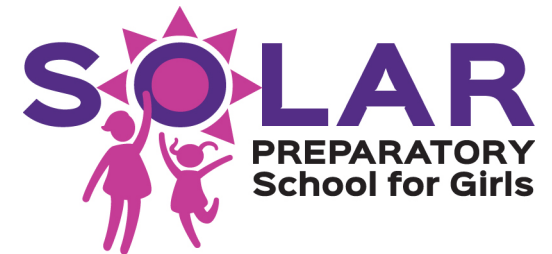


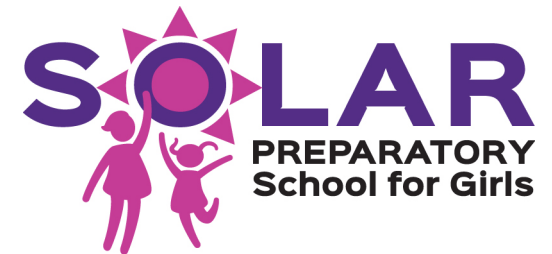

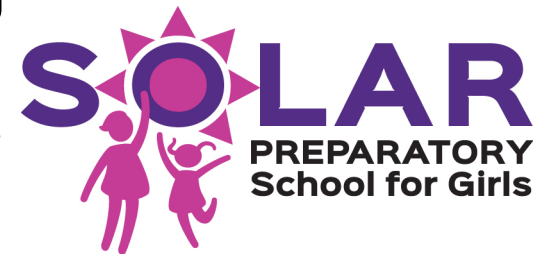
Vision

- Submit Two-Way Dual Language Application



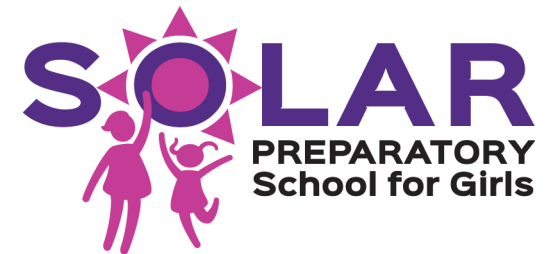

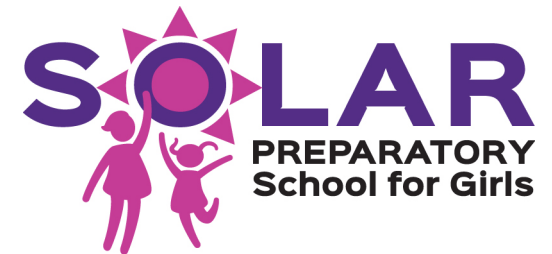
Family Day at the Arboretum
